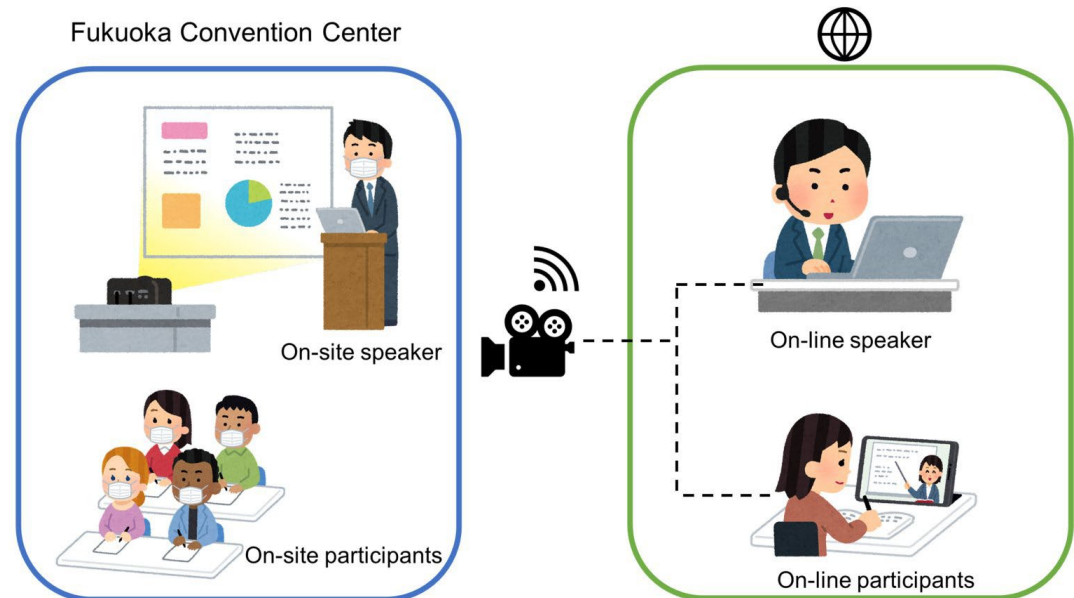
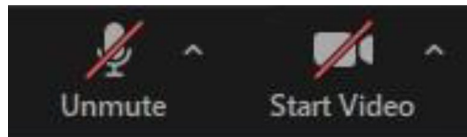
All participants and staff are requested to cooperate with the following efforts.

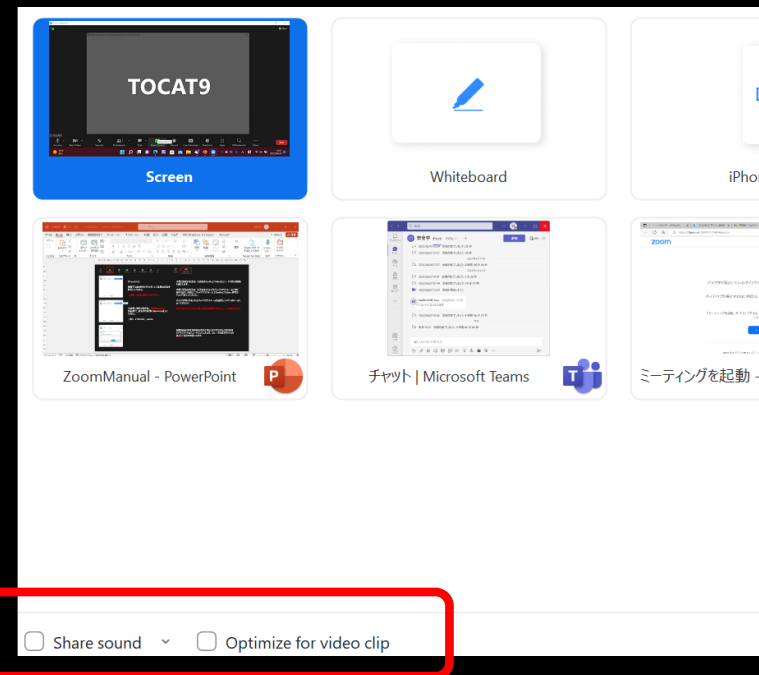
Online oral presenters

1. Enter Zoom at the presentation room **at least 30 minutes before** your presentation.
2. After entering the room, presenters will be moved to the Breakout Room (named “check room”) by the director of the venue.
3. In the check room, the setting of audio, video, and screen sharing will be confirmed with the director.
4. After the checking, the presenter will go back to the main session of the room and wait for his/her slot.

If you play a video clip, make sure to test it beforehand.

- Optimize for video clip

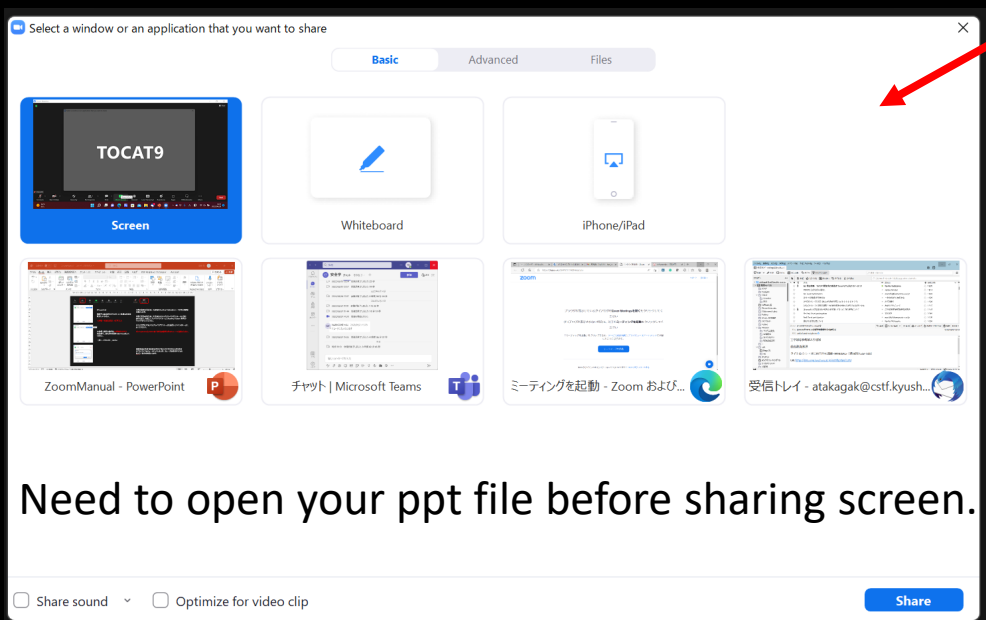
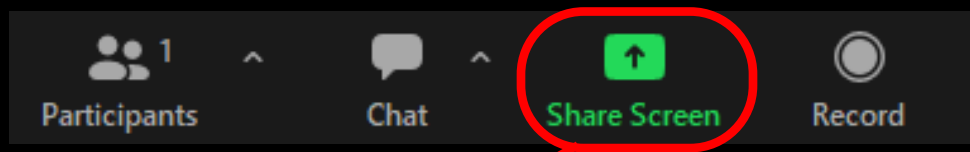
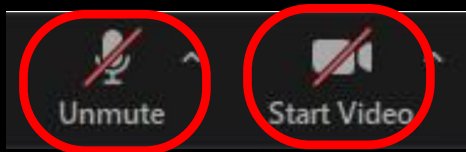

Need to open your ppt file before sharing screen.


